

COVID 19 UPDATE SEPTEMBER 14 2020

Various regions across South East Queensland, including the Moreton District, continue to be listed as 'Restricted'. This continues to impact upon R.A.C.F's, including Sunnymeade, in these areas. There have, however, been some changes to the Directions announced recently.

Direction No. 9 has been replaced by Direction No. 10 and is effective as of 11th September 2020. At this stage Direction No. 10 is effective until 2nd October 2020. The Direction may be altered subject to amendment as advised by the Chief Health Officer.

In accordance with section 29 G we have implemented a scheme that will allow for limited 'Personal Care' visits.

1. 'Personal Care' visits are permissible between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. Monday to Friday as of Tuesday September 15 2020.
2. There are no 'Personal Care' visits permitted on weekends, public holidays, or at other times.
3. 'Personal Care' visits must be conducted in the resident's room.
4. 'Personal Care' visits are limited to one (1) visitor per day per resident.
5. 'Personal Care' appointments must be booked in advance.
6. End of Life visits are permitted but must be authorised by the Director of Care, Clinical Co-ordinator, or the Registered Nurse in charge of the facility. (Note: More than two (2) persons are permitted to visit for this reason but all other requirements of the Direction apply.)
7. All persons on site, including persons attending the site to provide a 'Personal Care' or an end of life visit must wear a single use surgical mask at all times whilst on the premises. (Excludes Residents.)
8. All requirements regarding influenza vaccination and the requirements of Direction No.10 remain in place (Direction no. 9 is repealed).
9. Residents are not permitted to leave or be taken from the facility except to receive or access health care, to attend a funeral, or in the case of an emergency.
