

COVID-19 UPDATE April 22nd 2021

Dear residents, representatives, visitors, staff, and contractors.

From 22nd April 2021, there is a new Aged Care Direction No.27.

What has changed from 21 April 2021?

From 30 May 2021, you must have had the 2021 flu vaccine if it is available to you, to enter an aged care facility. This includes children over six months of age.

Please ensure that you provide us with evidence of your vaccination status prior to, and at the time of, your visit/s to this facility. (Exemptions apply for persons unable to have the Influenza vaccine due to medically documented contra indications or those persons observing a waiting period due to COVID-19 vaccination).

This means that visits to residents of Sunnymeade are still permitted, by appointment, so please contact our reception team to organise a visiting time.

COVID-19 regulations and requirements have not changed since the previous advice.

The second stage of the COVID-19 vaccination roll out for our residents will occur on the 28th and 29th of April.
